






#### The history of OP-TEE known to a few more people





#### The unknown history of OP-TEE




- ISSW initially developed by Nokia
- ST-Ericsson developed a TEE solution around it
  - Modem software
  - Android
  - Bootloaders
  - xtest (!)
- ST maintains the TEE solution






- Linaro forms SWG

- ST and Linaro rework the ST TEE to become OP-TEE




- Hervé Sibert names it <u>Open Portable</u> <u>TEE</u>








- TEE framework Linux kernel work starts

- Two additional key people joins SWG <u>Jérôme Forissier</u> and <u>Etienne Carriere</u>










